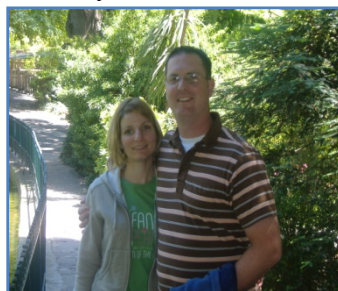
Praises & Requests

The Price Update

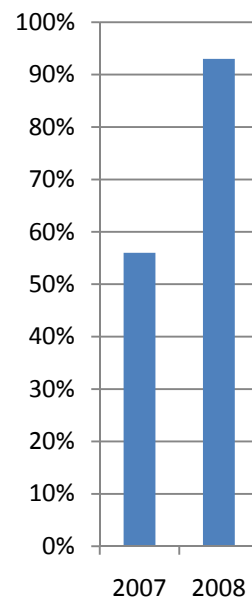
