## The Price Update

The last two months have been unbelievable for us. On 6/13, we received a call from the French consulate in Miami saying our visas had been approved. We were so excited that God had provided our visas. We were in VA. on 6/13, the next day we drove to Melissa's family and spent the weekend there, and on the following Monday I flew down to Miami to get our visas. I returned back on Tuesday from Miami, and made our final arrangements to leave for France on Thursday arriving Friday morning in Paris. The whole time we were just holding our breath to see how God was going to work out all the details. We arrived in Paris and drove to Toulouse, which is in southern France, and spent the

night with our friends who were giving us their furniture (It just so happened that this was the same weekend they needed to move out of their apartment). On Saturday morning we drove to Saint Gaudens and met with the missionaries that we are



helping initially while in France. We drove into town and stopped along the way at a car dealership to see what might be available. Within forty-five minutes, we had made arrangements to purchase

a car from the dealership. Afterwards, we went into town to see what we might find for housing. We went to one rental agency and made an appointment for the following Monday and went to another to see what they had listed. When we arrived they were closed, but we stopped to read what was available. As we were reading a man stopped and asked if we were looking for a place to rent. Within an hour we decided to rent the apartment he had available. The apartment was bigger and less expensive than any we had seen available. The Lord is so good to us, and has provided greatly above what we expected.



## Since We Arrived

Since we have arrived in France, we again have been very busy. We have been settling into life here in France and also helping with the camp ministry and church plant that we are assisting initially. The week after we arrived in

Saint Gaudens, camp started. We were able to help with preparation for the camp and also help clean up for the camp. The following week junior camp started. I spent several nights with the boys because they were

short a counselor. The first week of camp, seven children received Christ as their Savior. It was exciting to see God work in the lives of these young French children. Pray that the next sessions of camp will go as well.
