With camp over, things slowed down a little for a couple weeks but picked right back up with the start of language school and serving in the church plant in Saint Gaudens. Language school is progressing well for us. I am finally learning the "whys" of the language. I never learned grammar while I was here as a child. Melissa is also making good progress. She is beginning to make small phrases and understanding

some of the conversations that are going on around her at church and elsewhere. Please continue to pray for us that we learn the French language well and are able to minister to the hearts of the French people in their mother tongue. Most of our language class is filled with English speakers,



though most come from Great Britain. Our classmates have asked why we are in France and that has opened the door

for us to explain what we are doing in France. Some have expressed real interest in the church. Please pray that we can reach them for Jesus Christ. We are planning on having as many as will come to our home as possible. We have been warned that we can not witness in class, but we can do so on our own time. One couple (John and Nancy) have been friendly, and we hope to have them over in the next couple of weeks. Another man (another John) was actually surprised that there was even a Baptist church in the city. He did not think that there was anyone else other than Catholics here in the area.



Bible Stand

The Lord has allowed us to start a Bible stand ministry here in Saint Gaudens and in another city called Aspet. We have received permission from the city to setup the Bible stand when the Market

is going on in town. Each week there is an open air market in the center of town. We praise the Lord that we received permission from the City to setup our Bible stand. We have been able to hand
